

Privacy and Cookies Policy

This Policy, together with our terms of use explain what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you whilst you visit our site, and also how we use cookies on this website.

Information That We May Collect

In running and maintaining our website we may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information automatically collected about your use of our site including details of your visits such as pages viewed and the resources that you access. Such information may include your IP address, browser type, traffic data, location data, other communication data and your clickstream data, including dates and times that you visited our site.
- Information provided voluntarily by you. For example, when you register to use our site, subscribe to our services, register for information or make a purchase.
- Information that you provide or a third party provides on your behalf when you communicate with us by any means.

The information you give us may include your name, address, email address, phone number, financial information or other personal data.

Use of Your Information

We never give your details to third parties without your consent.

Where We Store Your Personal Data

By providing your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing and processing. We do our utmost to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to make sure that your data is stored securely.
